This toolkit is designed to provide organizations and interested individuals with the tools to promote and spread awareness about the STARTALK Multi-State Pathways to Teaching Program. THE STARTALK MULTI-STATE PATHWAYS TO TEACHING PROGRAM

The STARTALK Multi-State Pathways to Teaching Program focuses on closing the gap for heritage school teachers and/or native speakers by creating a Personalized Learning Plan (PLP) to work toward state certification. This teacher training program will support up to 75 prospective teachers in 8 targeted STARTALK languages (Arabic, Chinese, Hindi, Korean, Persian, Russian, Turkish, and Urdu) to address the critical need for K-12 language programs in Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia.

The focus is to prepare teachers to meet the licensing requirements of the state where they will be teaching and enter the classroom as effective educators with the skills to plan, deliver, and assess instruction using the STARTALK Principles and research-based strategies for language learning.

The partners in this program will help each participant as much as possible to work toward teaching licensure via the pathways available in the states of Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Virginia. Prospective applicants who reside outside of these four target states are encouraged to apply and will be admitted to the program if space is available (with acceptance confirmed beginning on May 15). The deadline to apply is May 15, 2021.

The program includes four Phases, all of which will be delivered virtually. The program will begin with Phase 1 on June 16, 2021 and sessions will be held periodically through February 2022.
